



Who is the Author?

SOLOMON?

ECCLESIASTES 1.1, 12

"Son of David" | "King in Jerusalem"

ECCLESIASTES 1.16; 12.9

"Great Wisdom" | "Many Proverbs"

ANCIENT TESTIMONY

Targumim, Origen, Jerome, etc.

Who is the Author?

NOT SOLOMON?

ECCLESIASTES 1.1

It <u>doesn't</u> say Solomon (contra Prv 1.1)

ECCL 1.12, 16; 5.7-8; 10.20

"Was King" | "All before him" | 1 Kings 11

THE LANGUAGE ITSELF

"If Solomon wrote it, there is no history of the Hebrew language" -F. Delitzch

Who is the Author?

QOHELETH / PREACHER

ECCLESIASTES 1.1

The <u>biblical</u> answer

KING AS LITERARY DEVICE

Not the same as pseudepigraphal.

AUTHOR VS. COMPILER

The introduction and conclusion <u>aren't</u> from Qoheleth (cf. 12.9–14)

THE PREACHER AS A BELIEVER?

"Under the Sun" | God in Ecclesiastes | Glimpses of Truth

THE QOHELETH AS AN UNBELIEVER?

The editor's bookends (chs 1 and 12) reframe his discussion

QOHELETH AS FAITHFUL SKEPTIC*

Speaks to hope in the midst of skepticism, faith as the answer to observation

Who is "Qoheleth"?



Vanity, vanity, all is vanity! (1.2-3)


THE THEME AND
