- Jesus is going away, but the Helper will come
- > Holy Spirit would convict the World
 - Convict: To find or prove guilty; convince of error
 - Sin, Righteousness, and Judgment
- Conviction Concerning Sin
 - How does the Holy Spirit convict the world of sin?
 - God has to teach us what sin is
 - Without revelation, we don't know God's law
 - > Verse 9: "Because they do not believe Me."
 - > This is the "verdict" (John 3:19-20)

- Conviction Concerning Righteousness
 - How did Jesus going to the Father demonstrate His righteousness?
 - > The world killed Jesus based on its righteousness
 - > The world's righteousness is totally insufficient
 - Romans 1:16-17 Righteousness of God revealed
 - Romans 3:9 None are righteous
 - John 6:63 "It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing"
 - Spirit shows us our righteousness does not compare to God's – our works condemn us

- Conviction Concerning Judgment
 - > The world is wrong about the basis of judgment
 - > The Jews judged Jesus wrongly
 - > The world's judgments are morally perverse
 - How does the Spirit convict the world concerning judgment?
 - According to Jesus, by what standard are we judged? (12:48)
 - > How do we understand the standard?
 - How does Satan being judged impact this?
 - > Cf. Hebrews 2:14-15

- > How is the Spirit going to convict the world?
 - Guide the apostles into ALL the truth
 - > Disclose to them what is to come
 - > Disclose to them what is Jesus' (and thus, the Father's)
 - Glorify Jesus
- > What were the apostles supposed to do?
 - Matthew 28:18-20
 - ➢ I Cor. 2:11-13

GÖSPEL JOHN

Your Joy Made Full John 16:16-27

- > You will see Me again
 - > And will speak plainly (they will be ready to understand)
- Sorrow to joy
 - > You will weep, but the world will rejoice
 - > Pain is necessary now for joy later
- Relationship with the Father
 - If you ask the Father for anything in My name, He will give it to you.
 - Jesus isn't going to ask the Father on their behalf
 - > The Father loves you

Do You Now Believe? John 16:28-33

- "I have come forth from the Father and have come into the world; I am leaving the world again and going to the Father."
- Disciples thought they believed but still were lacking
- Jesus would not be alone in His suffering
- > We are not alone in ours
